

Collection Analysis — Simplified

Follow the three steps below to audit your collection.

1 Import a Collection

Ensure that your books best represent your community needs. Import your collection information through the options below to immediately receive a Collection Analysis Report.

Each report quantifies the cultural classifications, genres, reading levels, text measures, and recency of publication for the titles you enter. A printout and a spreadsheet are included for your own documentation and continued reflection.

Please note that the List Analysis Report only includes information about trade books that can be found on Book Connections. Any titles not found on Book Connections will be excluded. Additionally, this report will not reflect any information about professional reference materials or classroom guided reading sets.



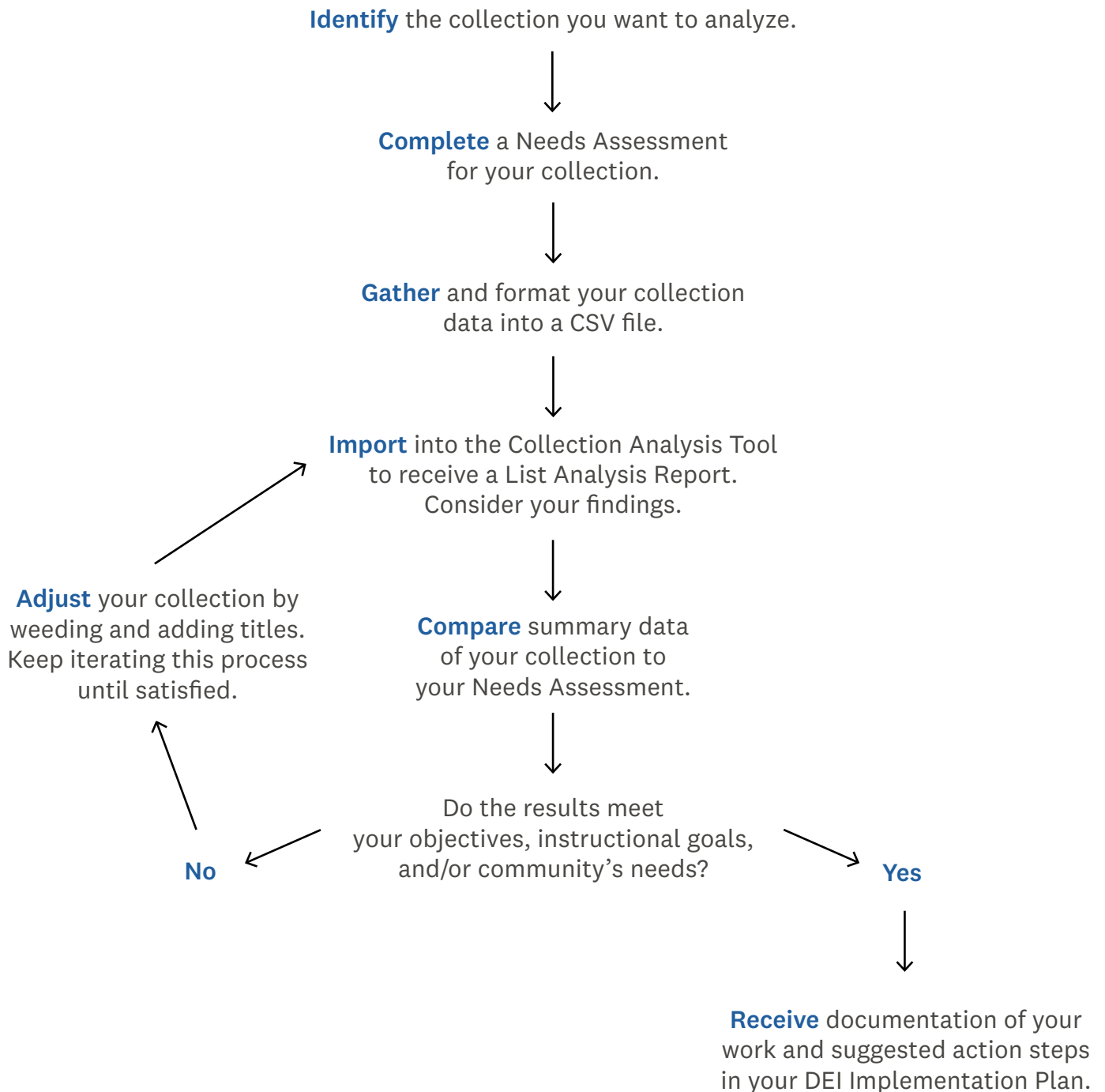
