1. The inventor of the telephone, who taught at a school for the deaf in Boston.

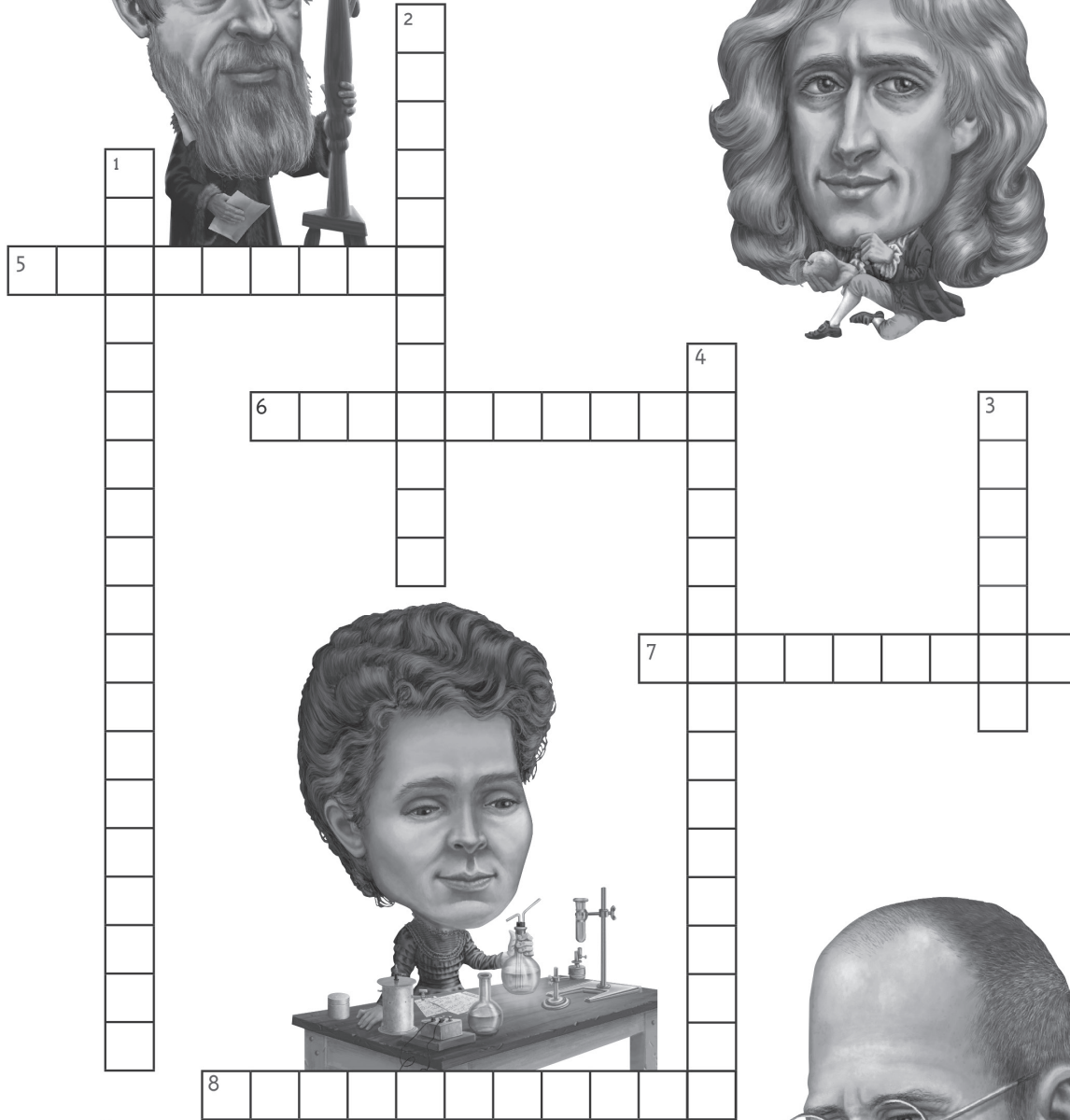


2. In addition to developing the first practical lightbulb, this inventor also created the phonograph (a machine that can record sound and then play it back again).
