

Use a book like *The Day the Crayons Quit* by Drew Daywalt and Oliver Jeffers to continue conversations about social justice. Follow up options include fluency practice using the <u>reader's theater script</u>, letter writing about an unfair situation, or watching the <u>Oliver Jeffers interview</u> about making picture books, then encourage students to illustrate their letters.
