Let's Play!

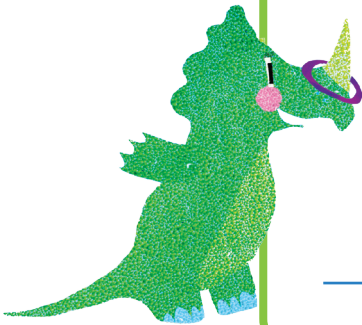

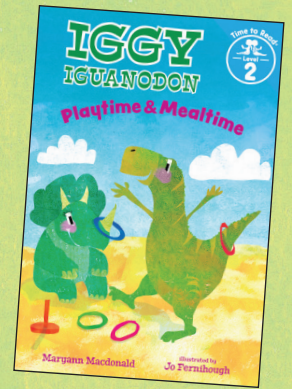

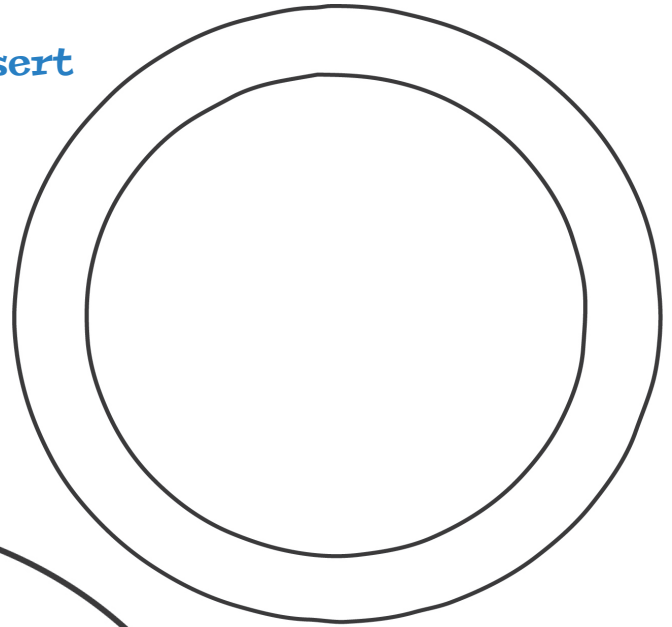


Dinner Is Served!

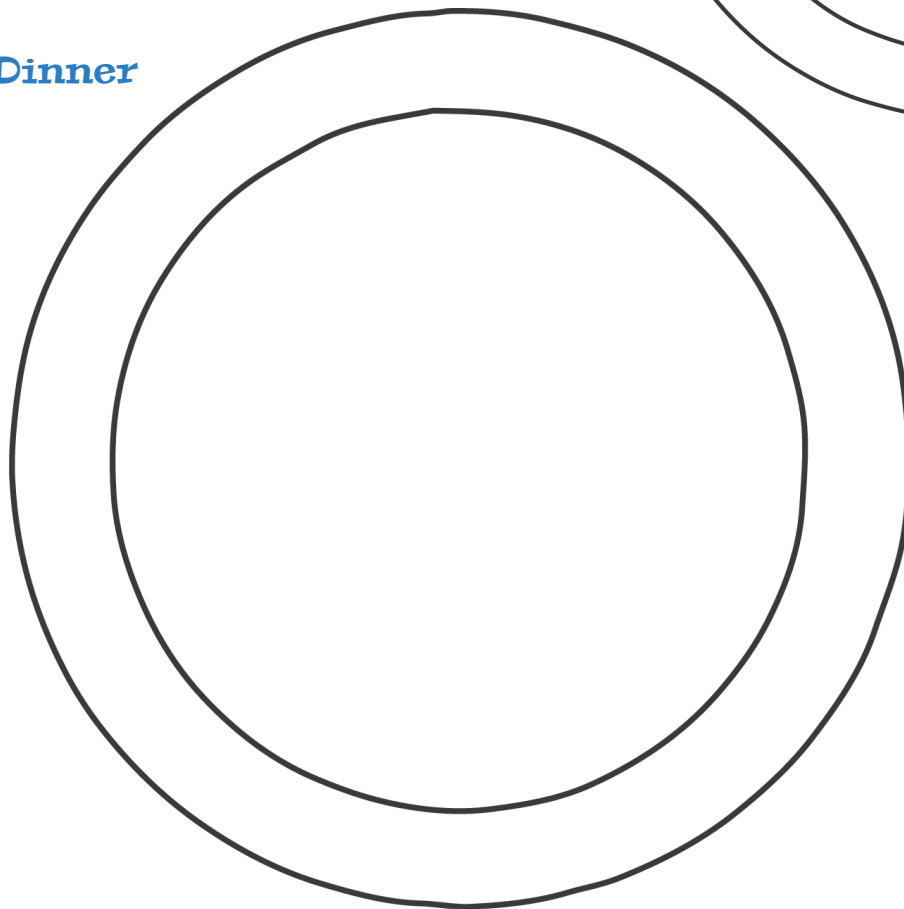
