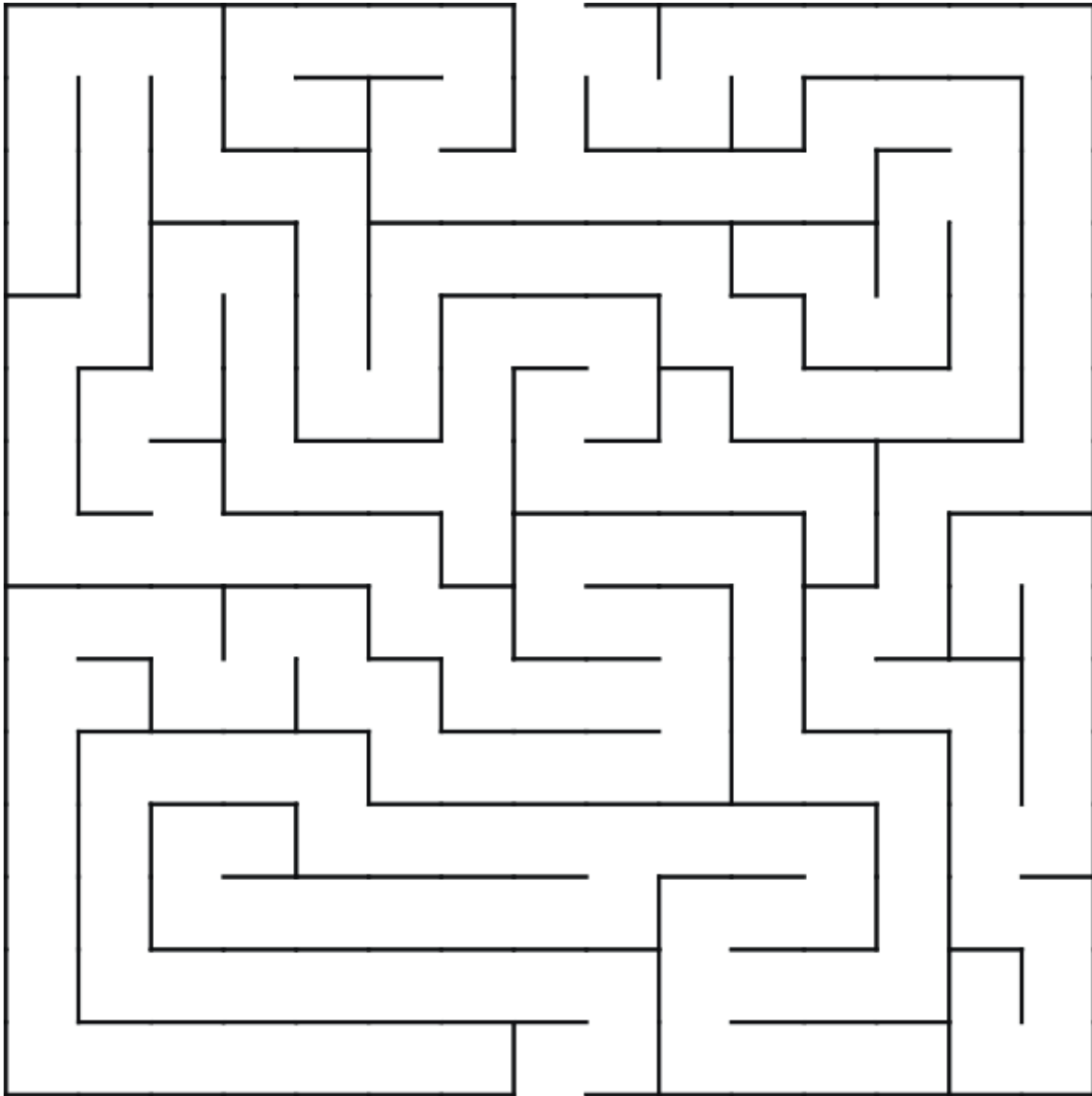

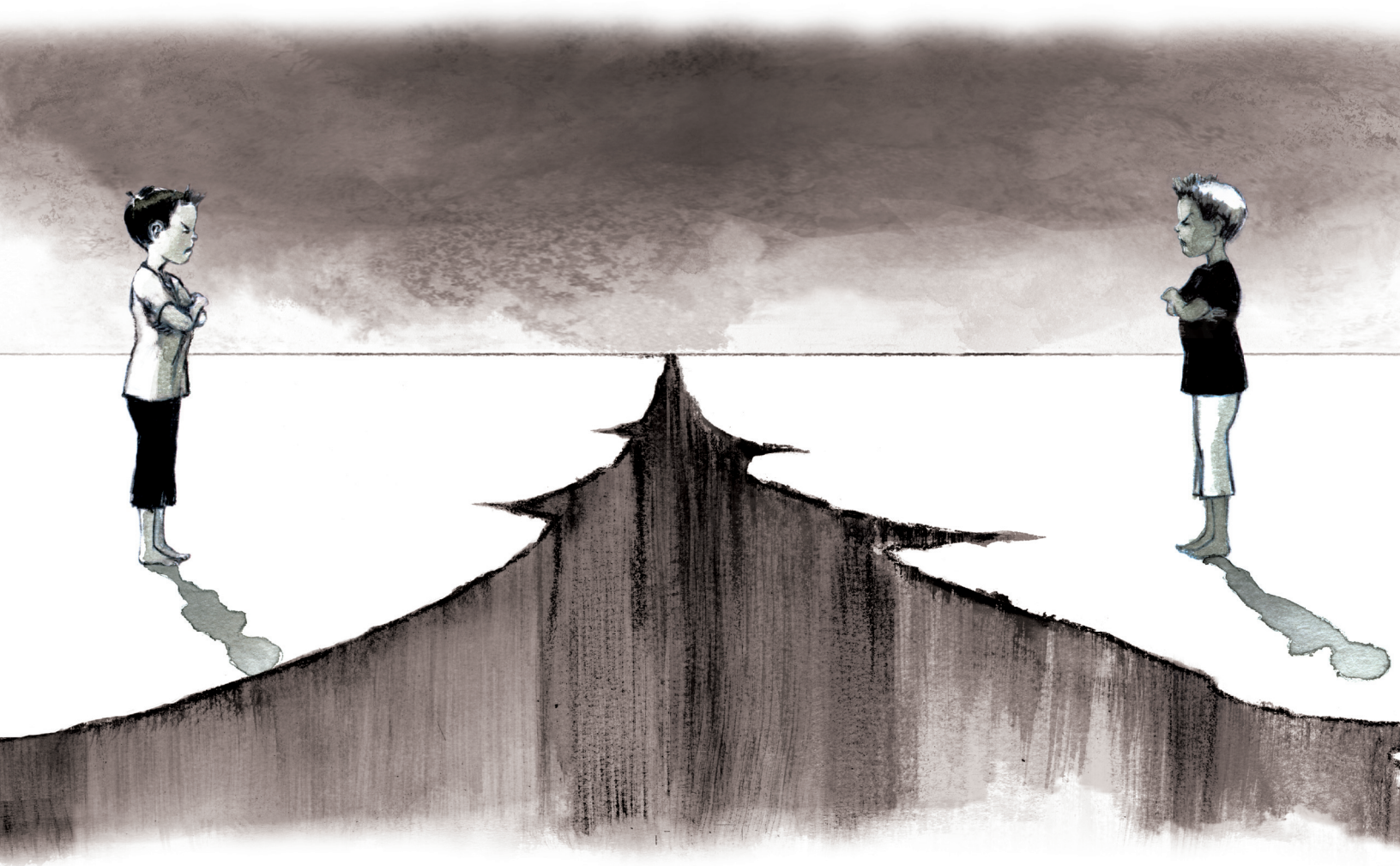

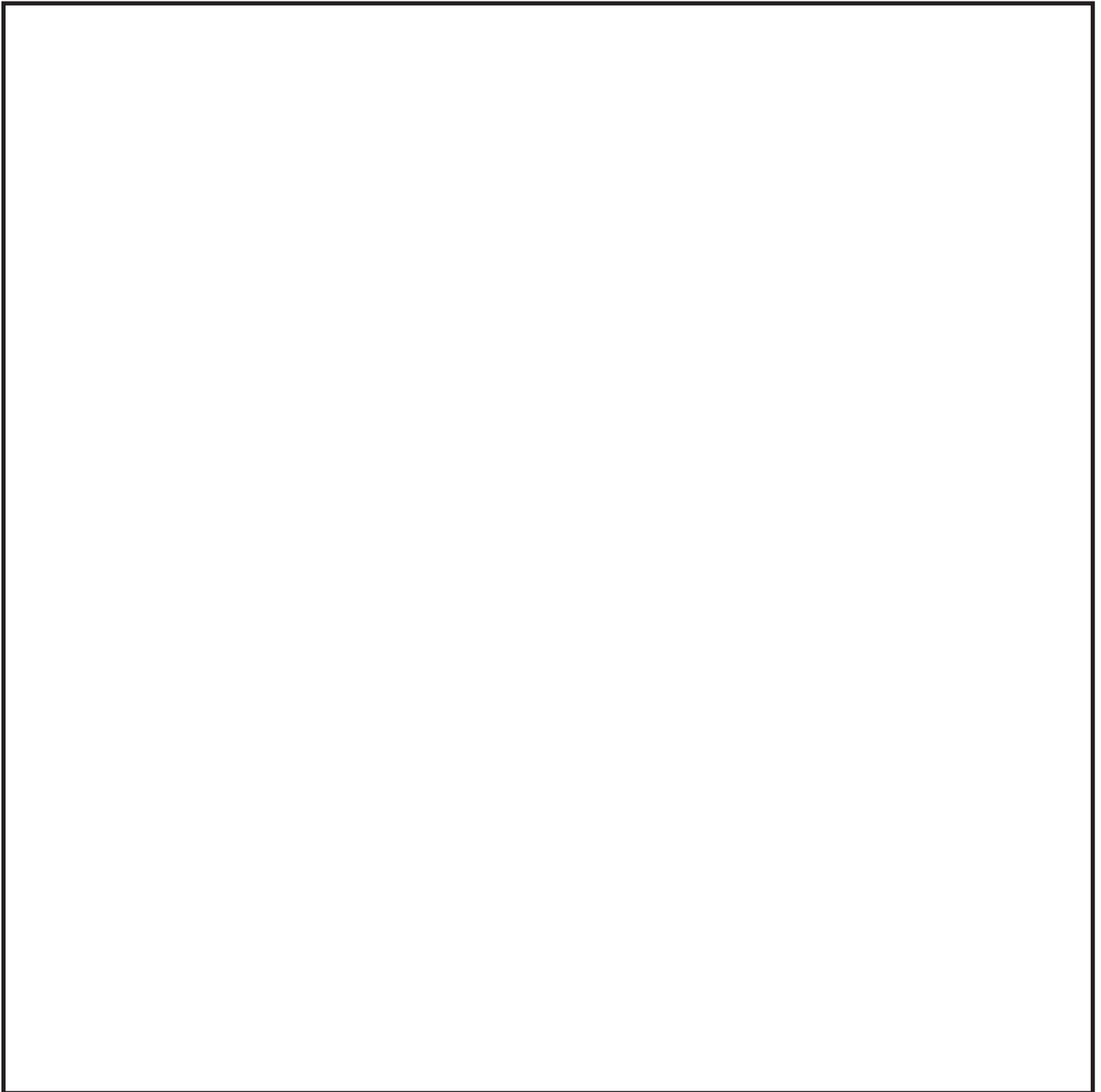
Draw as a Team
